It is a hospital-based fellowship program after MBBS in India, where students will be allowed to take up their clinical training in one of the hospitals associated with Texila with all necessary rotations as per the requirement of the Royal College of Physicians. While gaining hands-on learning experience, students can also gain insights and training from certified trainers of the Royal College of Physicians, UK.

Structured 3-Year Training

Workplace Assessments

Regular workplace-based assessments are conducted throughout the training program with an ARCP. Students undergo ARCP at the end of the year I & year II. A Royal College qualified expert (Program Champions) will be present at all ARCPs to ensure that the UK equivalent standard is achieved.

Associate Membership

Membership access from Royal College, UK, is provided to all the students enrolled under our program.

Practical Training

During the course of our Royal College Exam Training Program (UK), students will undergo extensive clinical and practical training at some of the leading hospitals in the country. Moreover, students are eligible to earn an attractive monthly stipend during the three-year period as well.

Upon completion of 3 years training students will be awarded a Fellowship Certificate and a clinical posting letter from the hospital.

Career Path

Upon successful completion of the 3-year Royal College (UK) training program and receipt of the certification, students can opt to work in any of the commonwealth countries, i.e., UK, New Zealand, India, etc., and are eligible to work as consultants.
